Non-Invasive Ventilator


This ventilator is similar to a CPAP and assists patients who are having trouble breathing without intubation. The patient does not have to be sedated while on the vent and ventilator associated pneumonia and other complications are avoided, making the treatment safer. Cost: \$12,500.00

<u>Cardiac Monitor & Central Cardiac Monitor for the</u> <u>Emergency Department</u>

Monitoring of critically ill patients in the ED is very important. The cardiac monitor will allow staff to closely watch a patient's vital signs, oxygen saturations, end tidal carbon dioxide monitoring and cardiac rhythm. It will also perform EKGs. They are portable and will allow the ED to easily collect data for quality purposes and help determine the best location for the patient when they are transferred from the ED. The current central cardiac monitor is aging and newer technology is available that allows for more efficient care for patients. Cost: \$42,000.00



Patient Standing & Raising Aid

The Sara Plus is an advanced standing and raising aid for our patients. It is an ergonomic aid to mobilize patients during everyday activities such as transfers and toileting. It can also be used as a walking aid for our therapy patients and would increase safety for our patients and staff.

Cost: \$7,500.00
